

**Captain Shreve High School
Vehicle Parking Permit Application
2021-2022**

The following rules and regulations apply to all student drivers. Please read carefully, complete the application, then sign and return to the bookkeeper, Lisa Rogers, by October 5th with the following items:

- 1) No parking passes will be issued to students listed on debt list until debts paid
- 2) Receipt from payfort.net for \$20.00 parking permit fee (**no cash/checks accepted**)
- 3) Vehicle registration, proof of insurance, driver's license
- 4) Signed permit application with parent signature

PARKING RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Students must have a parking permit properly displayed while parking on campus.
- Students will not swap/trade their parking permit with another student.
- Students must park in regular parking spots. Parking in a no parking zone, fire zone, staff parking, CCTC parking without permit, etc. will result in a violation fine.
- Students are to park and leave their automobiles immediately upon arriving on the school campus.
- Students are not allowed to use their cars for keeping school supplies, books, etc. No one will be allowed in the parking lot during the school day without written permission granted by an administrator. Students who leave school early during the day may leave at the designated time.
- Speed limit on campus is 5 MPH. Careless and reckless operation of vehicles will not be tolerated and will result in loss of driving privileges.

Driving an automobile is a privilege and students who drive to school must obey the rules/regulations in order to maintain this privilege. All violations of these rules will result in a parking violation being issued and/or suspension of driving privileges. Failure to pay these tickets will result in more serious consequences.

Violation #1 - \$10.00 fine

Violation #2 - \$20.00 fine

Violation #3 - \$30.00 fine (and revoke parking privilege)

AGREEMENT BETWEEN PARENT, STUDENT, AND SCHOOL ADMINISTRATION
